## 4X8' SECTION OF A 2-SECTION STAGE



NOTE 1. The plastic buckets can be deformed to snap into lthe retianers. and several buckets may bed stacked to add height to the stage.

NOTE 2. A $10^{\prime}$ by $8^{\prime}$ carpet can be used to hold the stage sections together instead of the bolts. The carpet ends should hang over the fromt edge of the state (bottom of this drawing) to hide the buckets and to firmly hold the two sections together.

NOTE 3. The stage is somewhat compliant so that it can be satisfactorily used on a somewhat uneven parking lot surface.

## BILL OF MATERIALS

2 -4X8, 3/4" Plywood sheets (Lowest grade)
10-1x2, 8' Pine Boards
1 - Box of 1.25 " Deck Screws
2 - 3.5 " Bolts, 2 Nuts \& 2 Washers
16 - Free Armadillo Willies' 12" BBQ Sauce Buckets (Home Depot buckets are about $\$ 3$ each)

COST for 2 SECTIONS ( $8 \times 8$ Foot) $=\$ 58$

NOTE 4. The stage is designed for compact storage if the buckets can be nested.
