The award is intended to attract and develop callers who will support Plus level square dancing in the community where the caller lives.

THE SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship awards will be \$150.00 toward the tuition of any caller school that is taught by a CallerLab accredited caller coach. The scholarships and will be awarded in time for the Norcal Caller School, taught by Ken Ritucci and held August 18 – 22, 2011 in Sunnyvale, CA. The Board will hold an audition on Tuesday, June 21, 2011 at the Camden Community Center, Multipurpose Room, 3369 Union Avenue, San Jose, CA 95124. The audition will begin at 7 PM.

DECLARATION

The candidate must have belonged to a Plus level club for the last consecutive 12 months.

The candidate must agree to prepare him or herself to be a Plus level caller as described above under PURPOSE.

The candidate should have a caller mentor and be willing to listen to and follow the advice of that caller as well as the advice received at the caller school.

SINGING & TIMING ABILITY

The candidate should be able to sing on key, with clear articulation, and with appealing stage presence, as judged by the Board of CPSD.

AUDITION

At the audition, the candidate will be required to perform one well-practiced choreographed singing call to a group of at least one square of dancers in order to demonstrate ability to adequately call to a live audience. The candidate may use notes.

AWARD

The scholarship will be awarded based on the discretion of the Board of CPSD who will consider ability, enthusiasm and need.
